

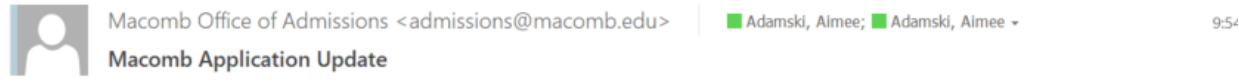

If you are under 16 when you are first registered, you will not receive a card. Once you turn 16, the card will be mailed to the address on file.

## PLEASE NOTE:

Since Macomb Community College campuses are currently closed to the public, we are unable to take your picture for your Macomb OneCard at this time. You will receive an ID card in the mail without a picture about two weeks after you have been registered for classes. When the campus is open again for service, please bring your ID card with no picture to the Student Life and Leadership office at either campus to take a photo and we will issue you another card.

*Photo identification (such as a drivers license, state ID or school ID) is required.*

The Macomb OneCard is automatically sent out to you the first day you are registered for classes at Macomb Community College. If you do not get your photo taken before you are registered, you will receive a card without a photo on it.

**Under 16?**  
You will not automatically receive a Macomb OneCard if you are under 16 years of age the day you are registered for classes. *Once you turn 16, a card will be mailed to you.*
